**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL  
BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR OF MAY 1, 2022  
THROUGH APRIL 30, 2023**

WHEREAS, the City of Morris, Illinois must annually pass a budget ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Morris, in Illinois as follows:

Section One: The attached annual budget for the fiscal year of May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023, be and hereby is approved and adopted.

Section Two: That all sums of money not needed for immediate specific purposes may be invested in City of Morris Tax Warrants, City of Morris Bonds, Securities of the Federal Government, Federal Insured Savings and Loan Associations, Certificates of Deposit or in Repurchase Agreements in local banks.

Section Three: That if any section, subdivision, sentence or clause of this Ordinance is for any reason invalid or to be unconstitutional, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section Four: That all ordinances or parts of ordinance conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Five: That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

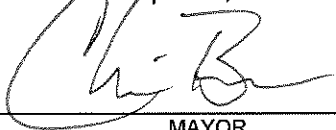
